HOW TO FIND US

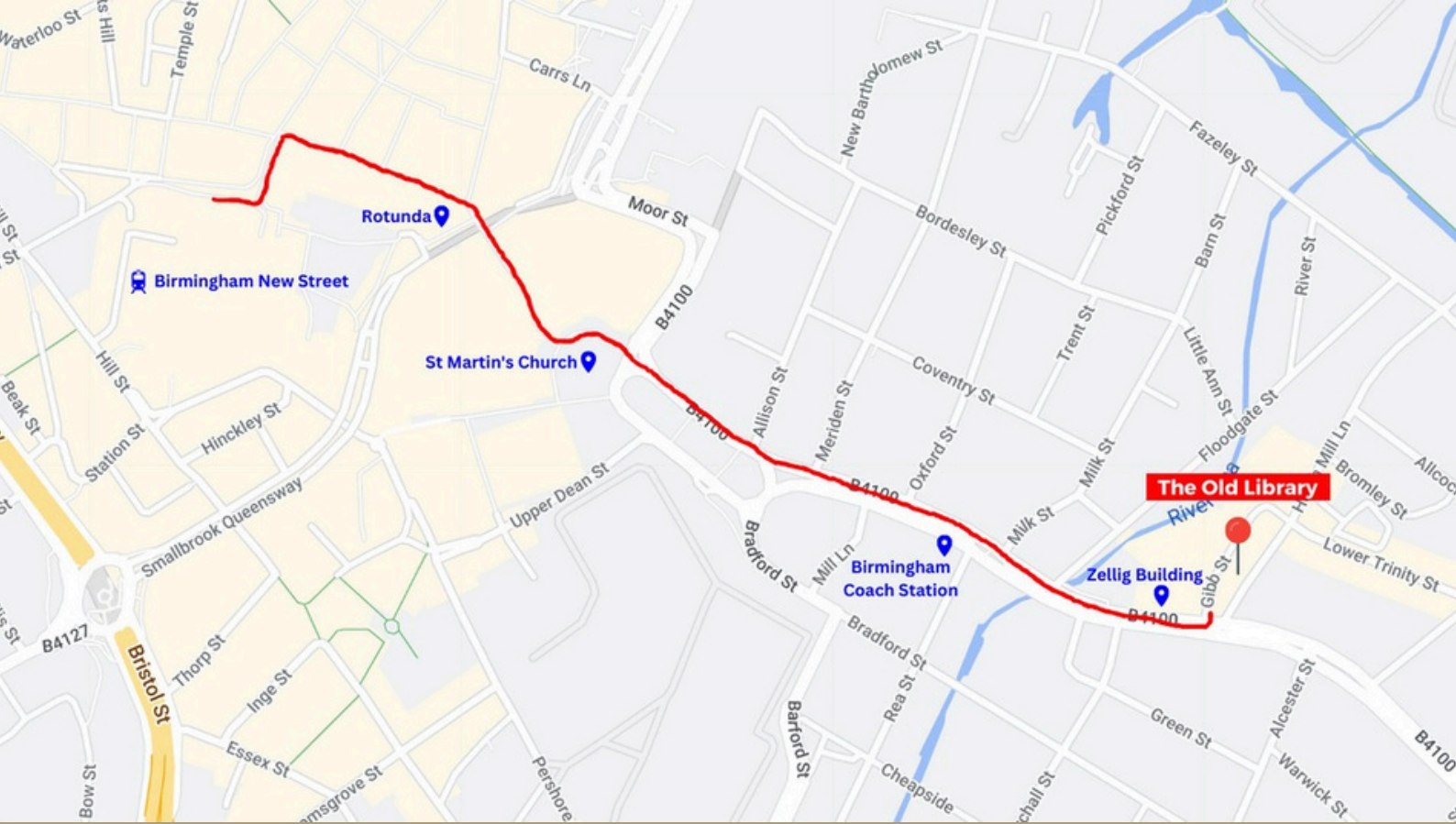
The Old Library is ideally located in Digbeth, just a 1/4 mile from Birmingham City Centre. We are easily reached by public transport, foot or car with plenty of hotel options nearby.

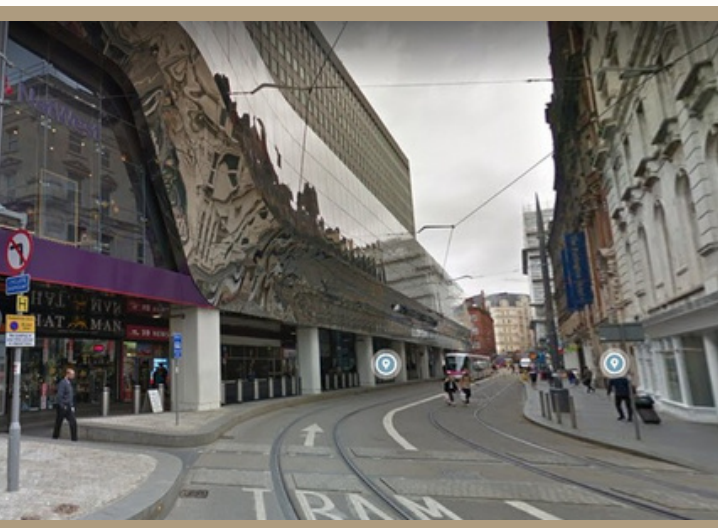


LANDMARK MAP

We have put together a map and a landmark guide to help you more easily find our hidden gem venue in the heart of Digbeth.

The red highlighted route is the easiest way to us on foot. Use Google Maps for a more accurate description of the area.

The following is a guide of the most notable landmarks you should look out for on your journey to The Old Library to make sure you're heading in the right direction.



FINDING US ON FOOT

Starting at Birmingham New Street, leave the station onto the Stephenson Street exit.

Turn right and head up the ramp and then turn right onto New Street.

FINDING US ON FOOT

After walking down New Street, you should see the Rotunda building on your right hand side. You will also pass the iconic Bull Statue on your right.

Look straight ahead of you and you should see the spire of St Matins Church. Head down this ramp towards the church.

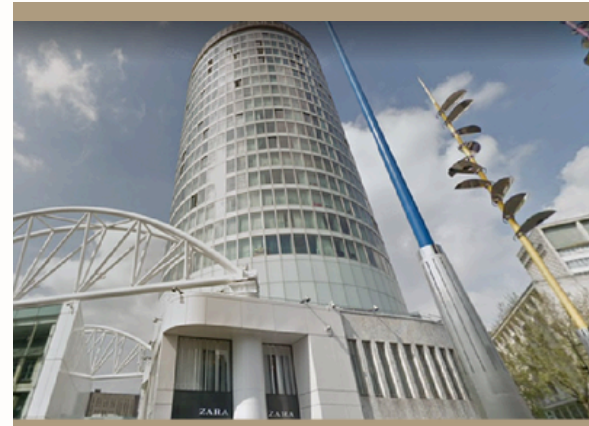
There will be steps in front of you. Head down these steps and veer to the left hand side, passing the church on your right and the entrance to the ground floor of the Bullring on your left.

Head down towards the main road. Cross the road at the traffic light crossing and then once more to take you onto the B1400 (Digbeth High Street).

Walk down Digbeth High Street, make sure to look out for Birmingham Coach Station on the right of the road to know you are heading in the correct direction.

Look out for the brown Zellig Building on your left and the large 'Zellig' sign. Walk underneath the sign and onto Gibb Street.

On your right you should see The Old Library. Our main entrance is painted grey with hanging greenery above our neon blue "Old Library" sign.



PUBLIC TRANSPORT OPTIONS

TRAINS

Birmingham New Street

Direct links to: London Euston, Manchester Piccadilly, Liverpool Lime Street, Cardiff Central, Edinburgh and Glasgow Central.

Birmingham Moor Street

Direct links to: London Marylebone, Solihull, and Stratford-upon-Avon.

It is around a 10/15 minute walk from both stations to The Old Library.

BUSES

There are plenty of local buses that stop on the B4100 (Digbeth High Street), just a 2-minute walk from The Old Library.

Trains

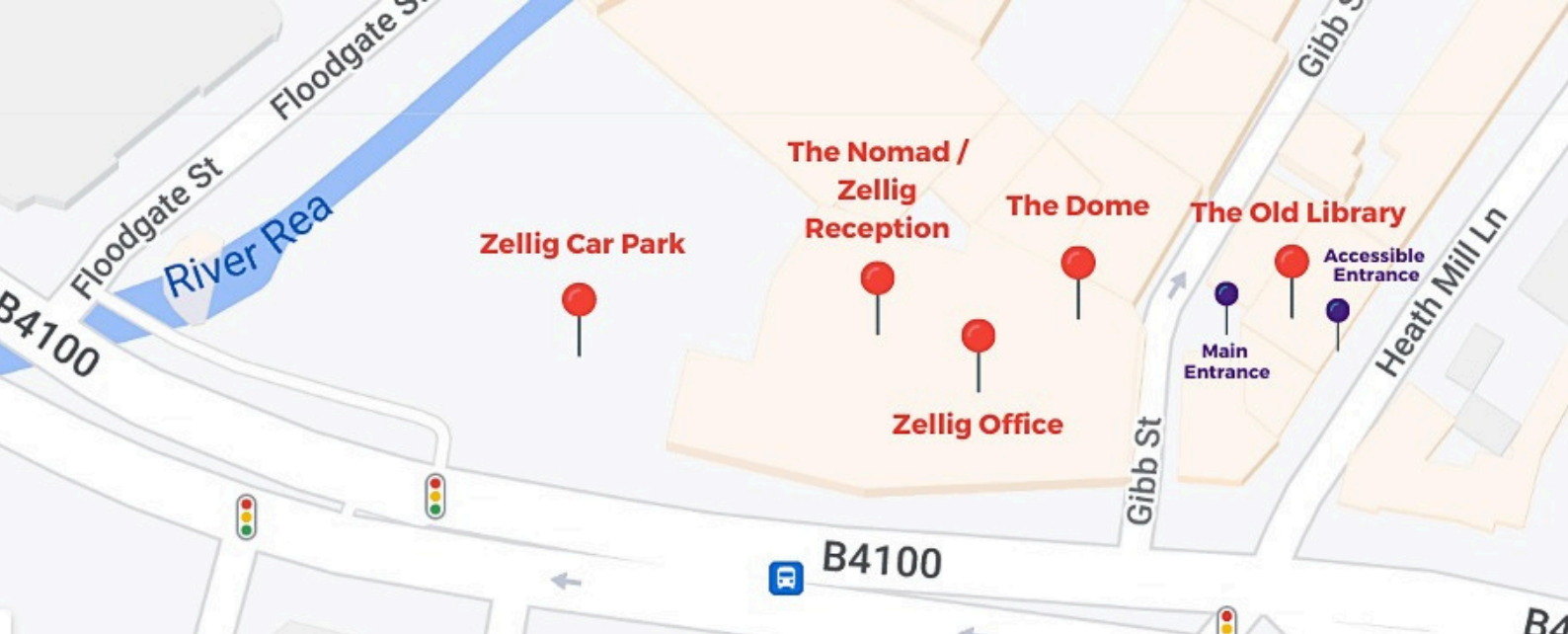
Direct trains from Birmingham International Train Station (accessed via the monorail) to Birmingham New Street run multiple times an hour.

Bus

Direct buses via the X1 leave Birmingham International Bus Station (accessed via the monorail) roughly every 20 minutes.

ZELLIG GUIDE

This is a handy guide to all of our important Zellig locations you may need to know about when you visit us.

The Old Library is just across the road from the Zellig Building, a place full of office space to let for independent, creative businesses. Our team are part of the Zellig family, being based in the Zellig Office.

THE OLD LIBRARY

Our main event space is The Old Library, where wedding ceremonies, wedding receptions, corporate events and parties take place.

THE NOMAD/ZELLIG RECEPTION

Just across the road from The Old Library is The Nomad, our wedding drinks reception area. The pods can also be used as small meeting spaces for corporate events. The Nomad is also the Zellig Building Reception on weekdays.

ZELLIG CAR PARK

The Zellig Car Park is a pay and display car park open between 8am – 9pm daily.

THE DOME

Just across the road from The Old Library in the Zellig Building is The Dome. This is an alternative space for drinks receptions. The Dome is also Digbeth Art Space, hosting different exhibitions throughout the year.
